



# PACKING LIST

## WinShape Camps for Boys at Mt.Berry

### 1. Bring \$10 cash

A car decal and dorm access card is required on Berry College campus. Your deposit will be returned when the decal is turned in at the end of the summer.

### 2. Bible

A devotion guide will be provided, but bring any supplemental materials that would be helpful to you personally for leading devotions related to our daily theme

### 3. Crazy costumes, hats, sunglasses, camouflage attire, etc. for rainy day Skills and camp-wide activities. ("Squad Wars", etc.)

One way to show campers that we can have a ton of fun at camp is by going all out and dressing up for our activities. Feel free to visit your local thrift shops or your hunting closet for CRAZY clothes!

### 4. Clothing

Staffers must always follow WinShape's appearance guidelines while under contract, for both during camp Sessions and during days/evenings off.

-For daily camp activities: shorts, t-shirts, undergarments, swimsuits, etc. Pack enough for two weeks. Bring a lot of play clothes that you do not mind getting dirty!

- Closed-toe shoes are required during all camp activities.
- Laundry Service is offered every two weeks.
- All Staff will need khaki shorts to wear on Spectacular Starting Sunday (Opening Day).
- Staff Closing Banquet: “buisness casual” or Sunday dress
- Returning staff please bring your rain jacket from previous summers.

### 5. Small Backpack or Drawstring Bag

With a fun-filled schedule each day and time at the cabins at a minimum, it is a good idea for Staffers to have a means of carrying personal supplies and items for the day.

### 6. Linens

Staffers should bring regular twin sheets, comforter/quilt, pillow, light blanket, towels (bath and swimming), washcloths, sponge, etc.

### 7. Room Items

Staffers are encouraged to bring an alarm clock, posters that demonstrate and encourage positive Christian values, radio/CD/iPod with Christian music.

### 8. Personal Toiletries

Staffers should bring necessary items to maintain a good level of personal hygiene. It is recommended to have a caddie of some kind to help keep your items organized.
